Late Work Policy



- When a student has not completed classwork/homework by the given due date it will be accepted up to (2) school days past the original due date.
- After the 2nd day, the work will no longer be accepted and a score of a (0) for the given assignment will be reflected in the student's grade average.
- It is the students responsibility to hand the work in. I will not chase after it.
- Students <u>will not</u> be allowed to complete extra credit at the end of a marking period in order to raise their earned grades.

Make Up Work



- When a student is absent from school they may have two school days for every one day of absence in order to make up the missed assignments.
 - Example: If your child is absent on Wednesday an returns on Thursday he/she will have until Monday to hand in the missed work.
 - Day 1-Thursday: Work on make-up work.
 - Day 2-Friday: Work on make-up work.
 - Day 3-Monday: Hand in work.
- If the student is unable to complete the work within the two days, the student will receive a (0) for those assignments.


