1. **commemorate**: When you **commemorate** something, you do something to honor or remember it.

2. **contemplate**: To **contemplate** is to think about something seriously for a long time.

3. **forlorn**: A **forlorn** person is lonely and miserable.

Lisa felt **forlorn** when her best friend moved away.

4. **majestic**: Something is described as **majestic** if it is grand and impressive.

5. **lyric poetry** **Lyric poetry** has a songlike quality and expresses the speaker's thoughts and feelings.

6. **sonnet** A sonnet is a **14-line poem** that expresses a single, complete thought.

7. **rhyme scheme** **Rhyme scheme** is the pattern of rhymes at the end of lines in a poem.

8. **meter** **Meter** is the pattern of stressed and unstressed syllables in a poem.

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
