1. **answerable**- If you are **answerable** to somebody, you must explain your actions to that person.

The soccer players are **answerable** to the coach for their actions during the game.

2. **lounge**- A **lounge** is a room that people use to relax.

The family waited in the airport **lounge** before their flight.

3. **obligation** - An **obligation** is a moral or legal duty.

I have an **obligation** to make sure my dog is walked and fed.

4. **proportion**- Proportion is the proper relationship between two things in size, amount, or importance.

The dinosaur's head was small in **proportion** to its bulky body.

5. **alliteration** Alliteration is when two or more words in close proximity begin with the same consonant sound.

6. **assonance** A poem with assonance repeats the same or similar vowel sounds in a group of words.

7. **free verse** Free verse poetry has no fixed rhyme scheme or meter and uses the natural rhythms of speech.

8. **narrative poem** A narrative poem tells a story.

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
