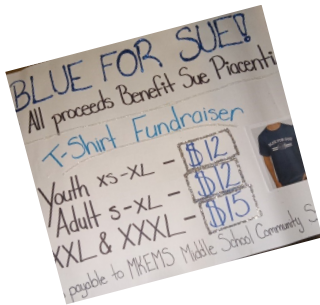


Ms. Sue was the heart and soul of our school.
