~Minimum size of the overall project should be at least 8 1/2” x 11”.
Maximum size can be up to 10” x 16”.

~All projects should include your year as the title. All projects should include at least one main illustration of a major event that occurred during that year-preferably in color. Small pictures/clips should also be included. All pictures should have captions.

~This is an ART PROJECT and creativity must be demonstrated!!

~All projects should include at least seven separate significant facts about that year written in at least seven complete sentences.

~Facts should include general and/or specific information about your year. Tell us what happened? Facts should discuss major events and important people or places. Facts can also describe important inventions, technology, elections, pop culture, fads, music, sports, and anything else interesting or exciting that may have happened during your year. Take us back in time.

~Want a good grade? Jazz it up! Make your project exciting. Make me feel like I want to go back in time. Use color, clip art, word art, illustrations, or anything else you can think of to improve your presentation.

~Need ideas? Need a computer? You can take a family trip to the public library.
