Keystone Exams are a graduation requirement for students in grade 9-12.

NURSE'S OFFICE

The Pennsylvania Department of Health mandates a physical examination be completed by a care provider/physician on all students entering 11th grade. The Pa

Dept of Health also mandates all students receive a Meningococcal (MCV) vaccination on or after the student's 16th birthday to enter 12th grade. Please keep this in mind and discuss with your care provider/physician at the time of 11th grade physical exam. The state of Pennsylvania requires that all students entering 12th grade must have a 2nd dose of Meningococcal Conjugate (MCV). If the first dose was given at 16 years of age or older, then only one dose is required, and that shall count as the 12th grade dose. Written proof of this immunization from your physician must be returned to the school nurse prior to the first day of 12th grade.

Failure to provide the necessary documentation will put your child at risk for exclusion from school.

ATHLETICS

ATTENTION HASD FALL SPORT ATHLETES 2025-2026

Any HASD student entering grades 7 through 12 next school year 2025-2026 and interested in participating on one of our FALL sports teams, is required to get a physical examination and complete the PIAA CIPPE form prior to the official start date (Monday, August 11, 2025 for all FALL sports except Golf and Football Heat Acclimatization. Golf and Football official start date will be (Monday, August 4, 2025). **The HASD/PIAA required physical (Section 6) and PIAA CIPPE form (Section 1 through 6) completion must be performed online.** LVHN (Lehigh Valley Health Network) is assisting us in completing this process. They are also offering a **FREE sports physical clinic at the High School on Tuesday, June 10, 2025.** Each team has been assigned a time slot and we ask that all athletes sign up under the correct team time slot. Also, **LVHN is offering FREE physicals at ExpressCARE if you cannot make the clinic at the high school. They will run from May 1, 2025 thru August 10, 2025.** Please visit our www.hasdk12.org website and under Athletic Announcements you will find all the details and instructions.
