What is Luzerne Learns to Work?

Luzerne Learns to Work is a program that gives 11th and 12th grade students in Luzerne County the power to explore potential career pathways through free access to LinkedIn Learning video courses, Metrix Learning video courses, Luzerne County Library courses, and several other local workforce and career development tools.

Students can then put to practice what they've learned and acquire skills through work-based learning experiences. These opportunities, provided by local businesses, will be housed in a database on our website that students can browse through, explore, and get connected with.

The Luzerne Learns to Work Scholarship

Luzerne Learns to Work will be awarding \$1,000 scholarships to ten (10) students in Luzerne County. These will be awarded to students who:

- Are a senior in a Luzerne County high school
- Are completed a learning pathway through the Luzerne Learns to Work progam
- Will be pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited institution in Luzerne County

Applications must be submitted by **Sunday, March 31st, 2024** at 11:59 PM.

The review and evaluation process will take place in April, and scholarships will be awarded in May.
