Human Costs

-<u>9 million</u> soldiers died

- -21 million soldiers wounded
- -<u>13 million</u> civilians died

-70 million people died from Spanish Flu Pandemic



- Economic Costs
 - <u>\$332 billion</u> = total "cost of war"
 - <u>American & Japanese</u> economies prospered
 - France, Belgium, & Russia
 - -farmland & cities were destroyed

-countries started importing from different sources or develop own products

Political Changes

<u>communism</u> became the economic & political theory used in Russia

- <u>monarchies</u> in Austria-Hungary, Germany, & Ottoman Empire overthrown

Unrest in Colonies

- the Allied Powers had fought a war to promote <u>democracy</u>, a political system colonists expected to receive

 <u>Fifteen</u> new nations/mandates formed before 1921

> Finland Estonia Latvia Lithuania East Prussia Poland Lebanon Transjordan



Differing Allied Goals

- America, <u>Woodrow Wilson</u>
 - <u>Fourteen Points</u>: President Wilson's plan for organizing post-World War I Europe & for avoiding future wars
 - within Fourteen Points
 - -reduction of <u>weapons</u>
 - -right of all people to choose their own governments (democracies)
 - -<u>organization</u> for world's nations to join, to protect from future aggression

Differing Allied Goals

- France, <u>George Clemenceau</u>
 - punish <u>Germany</u>
 - make Germany pay for costs of war
- Great Britain, <u>David Lloyd George</u>
 - punish Germany
 - don't weaken Germany
 - wanted Germany to stop <u>communism</u> from spreading out of Russia



Differing Allied Goals

<u>Italy</u>, Vittorio Orlando
– wanted to gain territory

-Italy was essentially ignored
